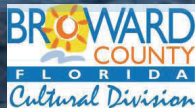

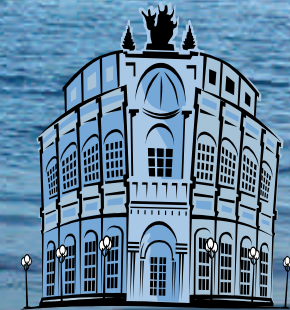

Chameleon's Fabulous Fourteenth

Exciting and diverse repertoire played by world class musicians in a relaxed atmosphere

We are opening our season on October 25 with Hispanic inspired works by Tomás Bretón, Ravel, Enrique Fernández Arbós, Shchedrin and Granados. Audience favorite Dmitri Pogorelov joins Croatian pianist Silvije Vidovic and cellist Iris van Eck.

The second concert on November 29 will bring string trio's by Bach, Reger and Muczinsky performed by violinist Misha Vitenson, violist Michael Klotz and cellist Iris van Eck

On January 24 you will enjoy the mellow sounds of the cello combined with the passion of the piano. Music by Couperin, Lalo and Onslow. Artists for this concert will be the duo Iris van Eck and Kemal Gekic

Our own Amernet Quartet on March 20 will perform music by Rimsky Korsakov and others TBA, together with distinguished guests

Our season finale on April 17 will feature Robert Davidovic on violin, Chauncey Patterson, viola, Kemal Gekic on piano and Iris van Eck on cello. They will perform piano quartets by Mozart, Dora Pejacevic and Polish Composer Noskovski .

To see what kind of experience you might expect enjoy an excerpt of a review of our concert on October 26, 2014 by Alan Becker (published in the American Record Guide January/February 2015):

"No! Chameleon Musicians don't change their colors in the middle of performance. Nor do they switch their attire in keeping with what they are playing. They don't even stick out long gummy tongues to assist in turning the pages of the music. What they actually do, is play with brilliance, energy, accurate intonation and fine ensemble.

The group, which has been performing for thirteen years, changes its personnel in accordance with the requirements of the music. This can vary considerably within a program, and takes place in one of the best possible locations for chamber music—the Josephine Leiser Center in downtown Fort Lauderdale. No stage, no formal concert hall, just a sunny (this is Florida you know), intimate room around which are grouped chairs within mere feet of the players."
